As we find ourselves immersed in the everyday concerns, cares and considerations, an atmosphere of gloominess can pervade. As my one time close friend and singer from way back in the seventies, Evie Tornquist, once sang in one of her songs...'the light of your life seems removed'.

As I pen what will be a shortened interim newsletter, I am very conscious that many of you have experienced unprecedented pressures in these troubled times. Conversations with many of you in Madeira, together with expressions in your written communications and phone calls, remind me that disappointment and heartache can easily destroy the joy and

Dear Evie, in her song continues:

'But what kind of friend offers help on a clear day and then leaves at the first sign of rain?

### **ROMANIAN PLAYGROUNDS**

We continue to be blessed and encouraged with all of the feedback and news from the playgrounds that have been constructed in the past few years, and we are now making plans for the next provision in early Autumn.

Meetings with Habitat for Humanity in January confirmed their enthusiastic involvement, so Calin is

now researching and scrutinising need and locations. Funding will be needed, even though we have raised some support in advance, so if there is any latitude in your budget for support, then this will be appreciated.



We shall publish precise detail over these next few months, but do pray for wisdom as we choose the construction site. We are particularly wanting to develop local church responsibility alongside these projects, and have now established a link with a network of Christian fellowships in Romania, who would develop some pastoral linkage with the school/kindergarten where we choose to be involved.

Again, please pray that this might develop into a strong partnership.

### **PORTUGUESE CHILDREN'S MINISTRY**

We were blessed to meet up with Ismael when we were in Madeira and to get an update on his 'Isma Pinta' project – the production of animated Bible stories that is being used by National Media in Portugal.



He will shortly be moving to the mainland where his network is much stronger and more easily accessible, and he is still keen to find the right opportunity to develop this resource for English speaking communities.

Pray for Ismael and his family as they re-locate and as they look for further developments in reaching children with Bible stories.

### **CHAPLAINCY**

Flame is still strongly connected with academies and schools and is involved at a number of levels in the support of Christian witness and pastoral support – particularly with students. The recent high profile case of the London school where a Muslim initiative to allow prayers in the playground was deemed 'inappropriate', does not weaken the rightful place and expression of Christian ethos when appropriately applied. The clue is in those last three words!

Saltmine Theatre Company recently visited Q3 Academy in Langley where I continue to be linked, and they were used to great effect with appropriate presentations,

workshops, and discussions that followed.

Gerry Denston and his team continue to be supportive of the Chaplains working in the Invictus Trust. Keep your knees bent on their behalf.

#### **PERSONAL NEWS**

I began this letter with a reference to the solar eclipse. Since the middle of January, I have been looking after my brother's health challenge as he was diagnosed with non-alcoholic, non-malignant, acute liver failure. He was admitted into the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in Birmingham and later transferred to a Nursing Care Home for palliative care where he is now based. He is 64 years old.

This experience has created a shadow over so many areas of life for Maurice and indeed for us all, but I do have to say that even in the darkest moments, I had an assurance that God would provide all of the resources needed for such a time as this.

God's light does dispel darkness and although there are certain plans and involvement that have had to be shelved for the time being, I am very much aware of so much prayer for Maurice and
